

Running target shooting at the Olympic Games (defunct)

Since 1968, women were allowed to compete shooting alongside the men. In 1984, the program was segregated for most events except of the running target events.

World Cup Finals - Running target shooting (defunct)

The ISSF World Cup was introduced in 1986 to provide a homogeneous system for qualification to the Olympic shooting competitions. It still is carried out in the Olympic shooting events, with four competitions per year in each event. For the best shooters there is a **World Cup Final** since 1988 (always together with rifle and pistol).

To the F, the following shooters are qualified:

- The defending Olympic, World, ISSF World Cup Final champions.
 - Silver and Bronze medalists of either the last Olympic or the World Championship, whichever competition that was most recently held.
 - The eight shooters that have made the best performances at the World Cup competitions during the year. For rating the performances, a special score system is used by taking into account of both the rank and the score achieved in the competitions.
 - As many as two shooters can be nominated by the host country to compete in two of the World Cup Final events if no one from the host country qualifies.
